**Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended)**

**Notification of grant of approval of additional overseas site – approved exporter**

Following your approval as an exporter (AE) under the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended) we have considered your application to extend this approval to include additional overseas site. Your approval is hereby extended to cover the following additional specified overseas site listed in the attached annex:

Your approval for these additional overseas sites is valid from 20 February 2020 and ends on 31 December 2020, unless otherwise suspended or cancelled. Your approval applies only to the named exporter for the overseas site specified in the attached annex and the letter sent on 17 December 2019.

Your approval is subject to the conditions of approval specified in Part 3 of Schedule 11 to the Regulations. A copy of these conditions is attached.

You must notify us immediately, in writing, of any changes to the details submitted with your application. If you wish to export to any additional overseas sites you must submit an application to extend your approval to cover these sites, including a fee of £150 for each site.

The approval allows you to issue evidence notes for waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) which you export to the specified overseas site and which is subsequently re-used. You must not issue evidence for WEEE that has already been partially treated.

If you issue evidence notes for greater than 400 tonnes of WEEE you must inform us immediately. You will be liable to pay the balance of the charge, namely £2,900, within 28 days of issuing the evidence note which exceeded the 400 tonnes of WEEE. Failure to pay the upgrade fee within the 28 days may result in your approval being suspended.

This approval does not replace any other environmental authorisation(s) that you may have for the site. You must continue to comply with these and other relevant legislation.

You must ensure that international shipments of WEEE are in accordance with the Waste Shipments Regulations.
